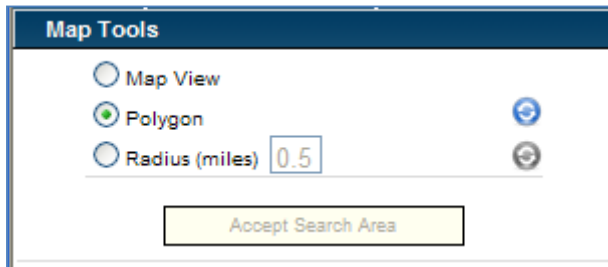


Map Search Using a Polygon

One way to search an area in a map is to draw a polygon around a specific area.

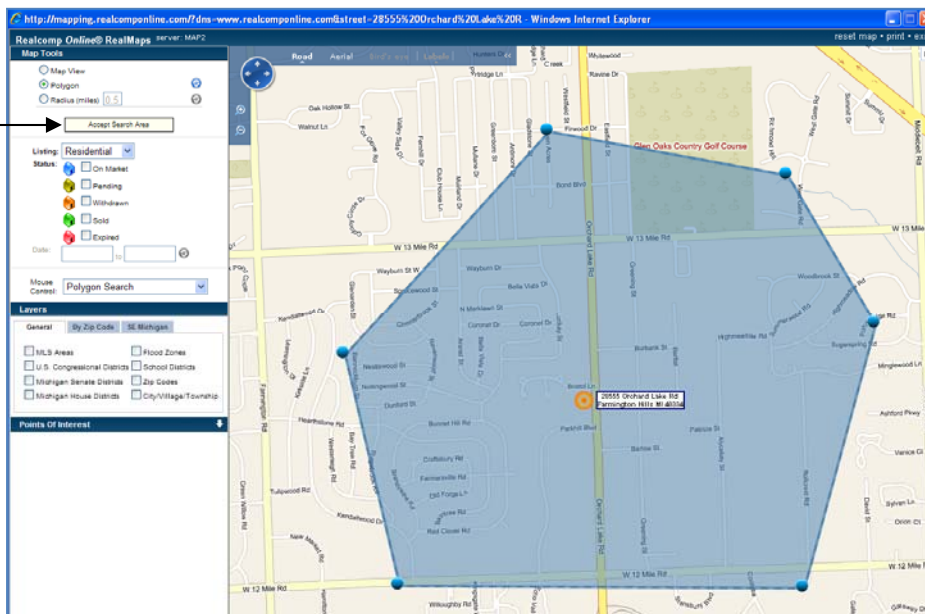
Select Search>Map Search and enter the address around which you'd like to search. Click Find to view the area on a map.

To change your search area from a radius search to a polygon, select Polygon on the left under Map Tools.

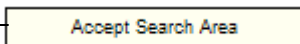


Once you have selected Polygon, click on the map to indicate the starting point of your polygon.

Continue left-clicking to add the additional points that make up the desired search area. Click on the red starting point to close the polygon and end the drawing.



Click the Accept Search Area button to add this information back into your search criteria.



Once you are back on the search page with the polygon information included, you can add any other criteria and additional fields to complete your search. Click Search to view results.
